A Letter from Our Pastors



March 17, 2020 Loved ones of Zion,

A Promise

"Do not fear, for I am with you; do not be afraid, for I am your God. I will strengthen you; I will help you; I will hold on to you with My righteous right hand." (Isaiah 41:10, HCSB) Our Lord tells us that while the world around us is full of fear, we have no need to worry. He will strengthen his people to deal with any crisis that comes our way. He will help us to make wise and loving decisions. He will hold on to us while he controls all things in a righteous way. We count on that. We pray to him. We wait and see what he has in store as his people who are glad that our righteous God is in control. Always.

Two Principles

God wants his people to gather for worship.¹ Especially in strange and even frightening times, we need to hear the words of our merciful, loving God. He assures us through his word and through the encouragement of our brothers and sisters in Christ that he will protect us and make all evil work out for our eternal good.

God wants his people to honor not just the letter of government laws, but the spirit.² In an effort to love your neighbor as yourself, each Christian citizen will do everything he can to prevent harm to his neighbor and to help calm his neighbor's fears.

We want to worship. We want to prevent and slow down the spread of COVID-19 and fears about it. In order to do that, our leaders have kept current on the latest reports and government recommendations and consulted with local medical personnel and reached the decision: WE WILL WORSHIP USING ONLY VIDEO AND ONLINE RESOURCES AT THIS TIME. We realize this is not ideal, but it is the best that we can do for now. Here is what we intend, by God's grace, to offer.

- ALL CHURCH AND SCHOOL ACTIVITIES, INCLUDING PRACTICES, MEALS, AND ONSITE WORSHIP SERVICES ARE CANCELLED. This is due in large part to the government directive that people do not gather in groups of more than 10 at a time. When this recommendation is lifted, we hope to open our doors for an on-site worship schedule. Keep checking our website for the most up to date information and links to resources that will help with strengthening your faith.
- A Sunday service will be recorded each week with a link to the video and a PDF of the service folder posted on our website www.zioncolumbus.org each Sunday morning. Please make an effort to watch this with your family and worship in spirit together with your brothers and sisters in Christ. DVDs are also available upon request for you to play.
- Offerings can be given online or mailed in.
 Please include a note that indicates your membership number.
- If you know of people who do not have access to internet or cable television (channel 980), please offer to help them. If you yourself do not have access to the proper technology, contact our church office.
