Another Major Reduction

Praise be to God our mortgage <u>principal</u> was able to be reduced by an additional \$50,000 this week.

Our current balance is \$1,350,691.64, a reduction of almost \$300,000 since the first of January. Of this, \$150,000 was in additional principal reductions saving over \$5,600 in interest per year.

After making this payment our building fund still has sufficient funds to pay for the acoustics upgrade in the worship area and the much-needed roof repair on the school. In addition, we have a nine-month buffer against the payments we make to American Bank every two weeks.

A heart felt thank you to all of you who have continued to honor your pledges to the Foundation for Our Future capital campaign that make this wonderful announcement possible.
